

**SOUTH TYNESIDE COUNCIL  
ST GEORGE AVE AREA, SOUTH SHIELDS  
TRAFFIC CALMING PROPOSALS 2024**

South Tyneside Council proposes under Sections 90A and 90C of the Highways Act 1980 and the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 to undertake the following:  
Install traffic calming (both speed humps within the meaning of the Highways Act 1980) consisting of full width Road humps within the St Georges Ave Area, South Shields.  
The proposed traffic calming will consist of a raised surface 75mm above the existing carriageway.

The proposed locations are as follows in the below schedules:

**Schedule 1 – Rd Hump (Kerb to kerb W x 4,0m L)**

St Georges Ave, South Shields	From a point 8m southeast of its junc. with Grosvenor Rd.
St Georges Ave, South Shields	Outside No1. St George Ave.
St Georges Ave, South Shields	Outside No4/ No5. St George Ave.
St Georges Ave, South Shields	Outside No10/ No11 St George Ave.
Tynedale Rd, South Shields	Outside No9/ No11. Tynedale Rd.
Tynedale Rd, South Shields	Outside No39/ No41. Tynedale Rd.
Tynedale Rd, South Shields	Outside No63/ No65. Tynedale Rd.
Readhead Rd, South Shields	Outside No9/ No11. Readhead Rd.
Readhead Rd, South Shields	Outside No 37/ No39. Readhead Rd.
Readhead Rd, South Shields	Outside No 61/ No 63. Readhead Rd.

The traffic calming is necessary to reduce traffic speeds.
