South Tyneside Council proposes under Sections 90A and 90C of the Highways Act 1980 and the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 to undertake the following:
Install traffic calming consisting of a full width road hump on Lizard Lane, Whitburn.
The proposed traffic calming will consist of a raised surface of up to 100mm above the existing carriageway.
The proposed locations are as follows in the below schedules:

Schedule 1 – Rd Hump (Kerb to kerb width with drainage channels x up to 9.0m length)

Lizard Lane, Whitburn	From a point 12.5m of its junc.
	with Westcroft.

The traffic calming is necessary to reduce traffic speeds and will replace existing speed cushions.
