South Tyneside Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the Order will be to Introduce no entry from Mortimer Road, South Shields into Cauldwell Avenue, South Shields.

The Order will also Introduce No Waiting At Any Time and No Loading/Unloading At Any Time on Mortimer Road, South Shields northeast side from a point 15 metres northwest of the junction radii with Cauldwell Avenue in a south easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres and southwest side from a point 8 metres northwest of the junction radii with Mortimer Primary School Access Road in a south easterly direction for a distance of 8 metres; Cauldwell Avenue, South Shields northwest side from its junction radii with Mortimer Road in a north easterly direction for a distance of 12 metres and southeast side from its junction with Mortimer Road in a north easterly direction for a distance of 29 metres and on Mortimer Primary School Access Road, South Shields southeast side from its junction radii with Mortimer Road in a south westerly direction for a distance of 8 metres and northwest side from its junction radii with Mortimer Road in a south westerly direction for a distance of 9 metres.

Full details of these proposals are contained in the draft order which, together with a plan showing the lengths of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be inspected from Monday to Friday during normal office hours at the Town Hall at the address below.
