

**SOUTH TYNESIDE COUNCIL
NOTICE OF PROPOSED CROSSINGS
VICTORIA ROAD EAST, HEBBURN 2026**

NOTICE is hereby given that South Tyneside Council, proposes under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to intend to establish signal-controlled crossing facilities, which may operate as either Puffin (pedestrian) crossings or Toucan (joint pedestrian and cyclist) crossings on Victoria Road East.

**SCHEDULE 1
Proposed Crossings**

Location	Description	Zig Zag Length
Victoria Road East, Hebburn	The centre of the crossing is to be 22m east of its junction with Campbell Park Road	13.1m east 13.1m west
Victoria Road East, Hebburn	The centre of the crossing is to be 16m west of its junction with Campbell Park Road	13.1m east 13.1m west

Associated zig-zag markings on which vehicles would be prohibited from stopping at all times will be marked either side.
